RE-OPENINGS!!

On Tuesday, April 6th the county moved to the **ORANGE** Tier of COVID-19 county guidelines. What that means for our community is we will re-open slowly with the following areas opening NEXT WEEK, the week April 12:

Ceramics: 1-3pm, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday

Art Room: 1-3pm Wednesday

Billiards: 10-2pm, Monday-Friday

Lapidary: 1-3pm, Monday-Thursday

Woodshop: 1-3pm Tuesday-Friday

Library: 10-3pm, Monday, Wednesday, Friday; must enter through the hallway door on the pool side, next to the Computer Room.

Face masks and social distancing should be observed in all activities.

POOL NEWS:

The pool and spa will re-open on April 12th with some revised procedures. Reservations will not be required. The spa is still limited to one family group at a time. Pool hours will be 7:00am – 7:00pm. Cleaning and disinfecting will take place twice a day. Swimmers are asked to respect an honor system of only 7 people at a time in either of the pools. A mask mandate continues going to and coming from the pool area. There will continue to be no lounging or sunbathing. Hand sanitizer will be located throughout. For the time being, the pool will continue to be closed on weekends because we have no staff to do the cleanings on the weekend.

Beginning May 3rd BOD and Committee meetings will begin meeting in the Clubhouse Auditorium with mask wearing and social distancing mandatory.
