

Pool Guidelines

- The pool area is **OPEN FROM 7:30 AM TO 2:30 PM EACH WEEKDAY** for use at your own risk
- **You can call anytime to make an appointment for the next day. Or you can call on Thursday or Friday to make an appointment for EACH day of the next week.** Reservations will be taken by phone 760-757-3937 from 9 am-3:00 pm.
- If there are available slots for the current day -- a reservation can be made.
- Reservations must be made in advance and usage is limited to **45-minute** increments
- Waiver and Pool Guidelines forms must be signed and returned to the office prior to your reservation (First visit only)
- Pool usage is limited to residents only - **no guests**
- All attendees must observe social distancing.
- All attendees must wear face mask to check in, in any place where social distancing cannot be observed and when not in the pool
- Attendee **MUST TAKE THEIR OWN** temperature and if over 100 degrees access **TO THE POOL IS DENIED.**
- Pool capacity will be limited to **7 people 25% capacity.**
- Individual groups are limited to members of the same household.
- Lounging or sunbathing are not allowed at this time.
- The Board reserves the right to further limit use of the pool/spa facility as necessary to comply with local, state and/or federal requirements/recommendations, including but not limited to those issued by the CDC.
- Any individual who has tested positive for COVID-19, was exposed to someone with COVID-19, or has symptoms of COVID-19 is not permitted to use the facility until they are symptom free and meet the conditions to discontinue isolation recommended by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC") at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/>. According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"), people with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. According to the CDC and State of California, symptoms may include, but are not limited to: Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty

breathing, fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, sore throat, headache, and/or new loss of taste or smell.

- All residents must wash their hands with soap and water after using the restrooms. **Note:** The Association is required to implement a disinfection plan that includes the restrooms. (see below)
- **Restrooms and Showers will be inspected and sanitized after each 45-minute reservation, which means one reservation per hour. 45-minutes swim time, 15-minutes clean and sanitize restrooms, showers and changing areas.**
- **Hand-soap, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available in the restroom and shower areas.**
- Members/residents should leave the pool/spa facility immediately after finished using the pool and/or spa. No social activity should take place. Congregating after use of the pool and/or spa such as in the parking or other common spaces surrounding the pool area is not permitted.
- All other rules governing the pool/spa facility in the Association's Rules & Regulations remain effect. To the extent any other rules conflict with these emergency rules, these emergency rules control.
- Any person who fails to abide by these rules is subject to immediate removal from the facility. Members and residents who do not comply with these rules will be subject to the Association's Violation and Fine Policy.
- Any person who chooses to use the facility during the COVID-19 pandemic does so at their own risk, including the risk of exposure to the novel coronavirus and COVID-19.
- The Association cannot and does not make any representation or guarantee that any surface or the airspace at the facility will be virus free, or that persons using the facility (including, without limitation, the restroom) will not be exposed to the novel coronavirus or COVID-19.
- It is each individual's responsibility to exercise due care to protect themselves based on their circumstances and risk factors, which may include, but is not limited to, age, underlying health condition, doctor's recommendations, exposure to or contact with an individual that has COVID19, and/or recommendations/guidance from local, state, and federal agencies, including, without limitation, the CDC.
